Speaker Series Comes to Barbara B Mann Theater

Myers, FL. The theme for this series is 'Meet the Real', and will host three speakers who have inspired books and movies. The Speaking of South Florida series will start with Frank Abagnale on January 13, 2015. His exploits became the story for the book, Broadway musical, and movie, *Catch Me if You Can*, that starred Leonardo DiCaprio and Tom Hanks. Abagnale will fascinate the audience as he talks about how he successfully posed as an airline pilot, an attorney, a college professor, and a pediatrician between the ages of 16 and 21, in addition to cashing \$2.5 million in fraudulent checks in every state and 26 foreign countries. For 36 years he has been associated with the FBI and will share his expertise on preventing identity theft.

The second speaker appearing is J. B. Bernstein on March 4, 2015. He is the subject of the Disney motion picture, *Million Dollar Arm*, starring Jon Hamm. Bernstein was the mastermind behind The Million Dollar Arm contest. This revolutionary reality TV show and talent search for baseball players in India yielded the first two Indian-born men, Rinku Singh and Dinesh Patel, to ever sign pro sports contracts in the United States, both signing with the Pittsburgh Pirates. Bernstein's successful company, Seven Figures Management, has represented some of the greatest athletes of all time including Barry Bonds and Emmitt Smith.

The last speaker of the series is Aron Ralston appearing on April 15, 2015. His story of survival became his bestselling book, *Between a Rock and a Hard Place*, and was made into the motion picture, *127 Hours*, starring James Franco. Aron will tell how he freed himself from being trapped by an 800 lb. boulder, and how he summoned the courage to do the unthinkable. He has spoken to hundreds of audiences around the world, and interviewed with Tom Brokaw, David Letterman, and Jay Leno.

"We wanted to bring entertainment to South Florida that is thought-provoking and get people talking," said Rob Maier, Partner of Headspace Promotions, LLC.
